



## Infant Mental Health Faculty Registry

The Michigan Association for Infant Mental Health (MI-AIMH) has completed and launched *the MI-AIMH Endorsement for Culturally Sensitive Relationship-Focused Practice Promoting Infant Mental Health (IMH-E™)*. We are incredibly proud of the work done by MI-AIMH Board Members, Endorsement Committee Chairs and members in the field. There is growing interest in the endorsement as a way to grow a strong and competent infant and family work force. As of this time, over 160 professionals have earned the endorsement in Michigan, with many more completing their applications for candidacy. In addition, 6 state affiliates have purchased the MI-AIMH Endorsement competencies and process for use in their states.

In response to the increasing interest in endorsement and competency-based training, reflective supervision and consultation, MI-AIMH has created a registry of skilled infant mental health training professionals who have earned endorsement as Infant Mental Health Specialists or Infant Mental Health Mentors. This registry gives increased visibility to well-qualified infant mental health trainers, supervisors and consultants in the infant and family field.

What follows is a list of the MI-AIMH Endorsement Areas of Competency. Each area identifies training topics and faculty who offer training in that topic.
