Session leaders are experienced professionals whose backgrounds include extensive clinical and academic work, teaching, research, supervision, and whose current practices meet endorsement standards established by the Michigan Association for Infant Mental Health.

Attending selected or individual sessions in the Infancy & Toddler Tracks is not an option.
